



POOLSIDE BBQ USE

General Information

- First come, first served unless reserved in advance.
- In accordance with Club Ground Rules, exclusive use cannot be taken of the BBQ area unless reserved in advance with our Events Director. All private parties are subject to the applicable facility/guest fee.
- No amplified music is allowed for personal parties or events.
- Supervision: 1 adult must be present for every 10 children under the age of 14.

- Cancellations must be made 5 days prior to scheduled event or full charges may apply.

Swimming & Lifeguards

- Swimming is always at your own risk when lifeguards are not on duty.
- Swimming events or parties are limited to 30 people and may not be held during swim lessons or other aquatic programs.
- Members hosting a party are responsible for hiring a lifeguard(s) at the current hourly rate. For information on scheduling & hiring of lifeguards: Contact our Events Director, Sarah Sigg-Hewett.

Food & Beverage

- Food may be ordered and /or supplied by the Club. See our BBQ Menu or Catering Menus. Food may also be brought in by members and their guests.
- Members renting or using the Club facilities must purchase all alcoholic beverages through the Club with the exception of wine for a corkage fee. Corkage fees must be paid at the bar or the Members Relations Desk for any wine brought in.
- Please inform us if your event or party guests intend to use The Club Café services, so that we are properly staffed.
- Glass is not permitted in BBQ Area or on the pool deck.

Member Responsibility

- Members hosting events are responsible for checking in all guests at the Member Relations Desk and paying appropriate fees, informing guests of Club rules, actions of their guests, leaving the areas clean and reporting any damages to management.
- The play area and facilities are used at the member's own risk.
